Readers become thoughtful leaders, and books open doors to knowledge, imagination, creativity, and lifelong learning. Our reading programme, 'Read to Lead – Nurturing a Nation of Readers', continues to inspire young minds by cultivating a love for reading and encouraging critical thinking, effective communication, and creativity.

In continuation of our endeavour to nurture a community of enthusiastic readers, we are delighted to announce the commencement of the 2026–2027 edition of the programme.

The details of the programme are as follows:

- **A monthly reading theme will be announced for each class in the monthly calendar. Students are encouraged to read books and stories related to the prescribed theme both at home and in school. They may select age-appropriate reading material aligned with the theme from the school library, their personal collection, or authentic digital reading platforms.**
- Parent & Grandparents Reading Sessions will be organised during the session to strengthen family bonds and foster a culture of reading.
- **For Classes I & II, bi-monthly theme-based activities will be conducted in the Library Periods.**
- **For Classes III, IV & V, term-wise activities based on the selected themes will be organized in the Library Periods.**
- Students of Classes III to V will be encouraged to issue books regularly from the school library and maintain a Reading Log.
- Students will participate in Book Feedback & Reflection, book reviews, reflection sheets, creative writing, or discussions.
- Students will be encouraged to recommend books to their peers through Book Talks.
- In each term, a Book Fiesta will include Role Play, Open Mic, Story-based Quiz, Book Discussion, Reading Excerpts, Storytelling Sessions, Character Parade, Book Trailer Presentations, and Read-a-thon.

Nurturing Creativity, Curiosity and Compassion

- Outstanding readers, reflective learners, and enthusiastic participants will be recognised at the end of the academic session.

Student participation will help enhance their academic portfolio through recognitions and acknowledgement of participation in these activities. Avid readers and Read to Lead participants will be acknowledged at the end of the session.

The students, who may not have read the book, will also be encouraged to join in as spectators and experience the excitement! This will certainly motivate and inspire them to read the next title that would be announced in the upcoming month.

Through this widespread reading campaign, we endeavor to provide an opportunity to our students to enhance their skills. We look forward to your support and cooperation in our endeavour to groom self-directed learners, avid readers and future leaders!
